

## Chicago Coordinated Entry Access Points

Skilled Assessors at Access Points meet with people who are 18 and older who are facing homelessness (such as staying in a shelter, outside, or any place not meant for human habitation) as well as people between the ages of 18-24 in unstable housing to complete a housing assessment and explore housing options.
