

Rapid Re-housing Bridge Program

The Rapid Re-housing Bridge program is available for single individuals who have been enrolled in a Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) program without an immediate unit available.

- *About Bridge:* Bridge is temporary housing designed to provide individuals the interim stability and support to successfully move to and maintain permanent housing.
- *Eligibility:* Client must be a single individual facing chronic homelessness, unsheltered, and is enrolled in your PSH program.

Bridge Process:

CES provides PSH matches from the OneList to PSH provider



PSH provider request referral to Bridge via HMIS need status



Receives HMIS referral, coordinates with PSH Provider, verify client eligibility, and collects required documents

Completes Bridge intake, communicates with PSH provider/case manager regarding housing status, provides monthly case management until client is housed in their PSH unit
